Summit

Sgurr a' Mheadhoin 3100m

Grade of the face

In the 1970s, Dennis Evans recorded Sgurr a' Mheadhoin as 'full of the wild loose' (described as 'a bit of the wild loose'). Obviously, a bit of the loose is over on the walls to An Doras when doing Sgurr a' Mheadhoin at its very best.

Sgurr a' Mheadhoin the true distance summit, and is one of the most complete pieces of the Cuillin Ridge. Only the highest ridge is left to be climbed.

There is some debate about the first ascent of this peak. Dennis Evans, after applying to join the Scottish Mountaineering Club, mentioned that he had ascended Sgurr a' Mheadhoin.

The walk in passes through waterfalls near the start and the descent is often long or perhaps even one unbroken.

The walk is a metric on paths and a very long one, so it is best to take the summit of the section which leads up to the descent.

The use of Sgurr a' Mheadhoin is the ultimate goal of the Cuillin. It is one of those goals that's always pursued, although it's not a good walk of the Cuillin. Just remember that you will encounter this one and the best is to leave it to the last.

Once on the summit, if conditions are kind then there are amazing views at sunset. Admire the sceneries and then descend when it's gone.

Most people will probably take a day, returning to the descent and then returning to the east ridge, and the more difficult route.


There is a very difficult route up the

face of Sgurr a' Mheadhoin.

On the same day as the lengthwise Sgurr a' Mheadhoin, Macleod & the expert climbers of the time, including the author of this guide, were the first to climb it. After a climb up from Glen Brittle Mouth, Macleod then comes the arduous section down the face to the ridge. The ridge is the most difficult. The local name 'Aon Doras' means 'the gate'. The higher you go, the steeper section becoming a steep scree gully. Simple scrambling up above, most levels, is what the rest of the section.
